Volunteer Positions

Foster Care

Provide shelter for sick, injured or very young animals in your home.

Skills and equipment needed: None. Food, supplies and medical care are paid for and provided by HSSF.

Time commitment: varies (depending on individual animal but can range from a few days to three months or longer)

Used Book Store

We need volunteers to help at the Auburn book store; sorting, and shelving books and helping customers with sales.

Skills and equipment needed: Ability to lift about 15-30# and transportation.

Time commitment: 4-6 hours per week.

Used Book Collections

We need volunteers to solicit donations of books, CD's and DVD's. They can either make collections from friends and family members and/or set-up and monitor collection bins in their neighborhood.

Skills and equipment needed: Ability to lift about 15-30# and transportation.

Time commitment: set own schedule sufficient to manage bins.

Animal Cruelty Reward Program

When animal abuse occurs, sometimes a reward encourages witnesses to come forward and identify the suspect. Volunteers will assist our Humane Officer by canvassing neighborhoods where the animal abuse took place to distribute reward flyers and talk with residents.

Skills and equipment needed: Transportation. Volunteers must be 18+ years of age.

Time commitment: 4-6 hours.

Thrift & Gift Shop

We need volunteers to help at the Auburn resale store; helping customers with sales, preparing donations for sale, i.e., cleaning, polishing etc. Organizing sale displays.

Skills and equipment needed: Ability to lift up to 30#. No special equipment needed.

Time commitment: Minimum 4 hours per week.
